Call to Order and Introduction

The Mabry Charger Foundation ("MCF") meeting was called to order at 11:06.

Secretary Report

Kimberly provided the Secretary Report.

Treasurer Report

Mahafrin reviewed the Treasurer Report.

- The report does not include Reality U and Charger Chase funds.
- Mahafrin requested to close out the old account to zero and will move the balance to the main Truist account.
- The MCF will need to budget for a person or firm to file taxes next year, with this being solidified by the first of the year.

Principal's Report

Mr. Tanner provided the Principal's Report.

- Cheri Young is seeking funds for Science Olympiad supplies.
- MCF is asking for \$2,000 for the kit, which has an actual cost closer to \$700, and includes \$200 in reserve.

Fundraising Updates

A total of **\$32,017.51** has been raised (updated 11/13).

- **Membership:** \$3,100 from 30 Silver Memberships (\$50) and 16 Gold Memberships (\$100).
- **Donations:** \$1,563.50 total.
 - \$715 from extra membership donations.
 - \$408.50 from extra bundle donations.
 - \$120 from extra marquee donations.
 - \$320 from the donation link.
- **Birthday Marquee:** \$1,440 (72 sold).
- **8th Grade Bundle:** \$4,580 (69 sold with 40 adding delivery).
- **Charger Chase:** \$22,645.

Old Business

- **Charger Chase Recap:** The profit was \$22,645.01, with \$32,402 raised and expenses of \$9,756.99 (\$7,500 for Activate Cost). Needs include:
 - Securing three potential dates for next year.
 - Feedback from Student Forum on potential rewards.
 - Sending thank yous to sponsors.
- **Mabry School Tours:** The first tour was canceled due to no registration. Upcoming tour dates include:
 - December 11 (Sydney).
 - January 8, February 12, March 12, April 16 in 2026.
 - Need to confirm a date to present with the PTSA.
- **Taxes:** 2024 extensions were accepted, and Mahafrin will follow up on filing returns for both entities.
- **RealityU Recap:** Kimberly is discussing promotion and volunteers with the Reality U representative for next year. Suggestions included communicating that lunch is provided, starting communication earlier, and confirming payment to Reality U.
- **8th Grade Bundle Shirts:** Kimberly is handling the discussion of design/supplier and setting up a payment link for ordering just a shirt.
- **Foundation Updates:** Updates include a revised logo, updated bylaws, domain name change, and new shirts. Kimberly is also handling the Canva/Google Non-Profit Accounts setup.

New Business

- **Branding & Signage:** The SPLOST fund was approved on November 13th.
 - Mr. Tanner will investigate who to pay, and MCF will reimburse the school.

- A quote for Learning Commons signage is \$3,812.72.
- Remaining signage is \$12,647, including Pole Banners, HEART Signs, an M Logo Sign, Cafeteria Soffit Wrap, Front Entrance Doors, and Retractable Banners.
- There is a cost for Setup & Design (\$600) and installation (\$1,080).
- **STEAM Night (March 5):** We will not have new shirts this year. The Wild Eyed BBQ food truck is confirmed. There will be no shirt sales, but a contest will be held for the logo design, coordinated through a school-wide call for entries.
